### +Exhibition "Extinctions!?" - Rock art of the Serranía de la Lindosa +

On February 21, the exhibition "Extinctions!?" of the TAKING CARE Project opened at the Weltmuseum Wien. This exhibition questions the usual stories about extinction and retells them from other perspectives. Colombia participates with indigenous art from the Serranía de la Lindosa with a reproduction of a mural by Colombian artist **Juan Muñoz.** The exhibition has **free admission** and will be on display until April 2, 2024.

On May 23rd, the first Rock Art/Gipri workshop on the indigenous art of the Serranía de la Lindosa in Colombia was held. Surrounded by a reproduction of a mural of the Lindosa, attendees were transported to the Colombian Guaviare and were able to reflect on this impressive and mysterious archaeological monument. The event was led by Juan Muñoz (Organización Mundo Redondo), in charge of the elaboration of the replica, who provided an entertaining historical, anthropological and artistic tour of rock art in South America. The afternoon ended with a practical exercise in which the attendees were able to make their own replicas of the mural and experience the complexity of this thousands of years old art. The next workshop will be held on September 19.

Throughout these 20 years, IBÉRICA has positioned itself as the largest platform for the dissemination of Ibero-American culture, not only in the Czech Republic, but also in the Central European region. As has been the case every year, the festival will feature the participation of various Colombian artists.

The Colombian participation in IBÉRICA 2023 will be headed by the concert of the Colombian singer **Laura Aya** at the "After Party" celebrating the 20th Anniversary, on June 17 at the Špilberk Castle in Brno after the traditional Gala Concert. Another Colombian representation will be the participation of the Bogotan choreographer and dancer **Álvaro Vargas**, who

will give workshops on salsa, Latin rhythms and Argentine tango in the Iberoamerican Zone in Brno the weekends of 16 to 19 of June and 24 to 25 of June. Finally, "MadreMonte", the legendary play of Colombian mythology will be presented on June 24 by the actress **Veronika Všianská** and her Micro-Theater as part of the program prepared by Zona Iberoamericana for the IBÉRICA festival.

Last year, as part of the Plan for Promotion Abroad, the Embassy of Colombia in Austria invited the muralist Soma Difusa to participate in the urban art festival Calle Libre (Vienna), which is the largest of its kind in Central Europe. More than 20 artists from all over the world painted their murals at the **former Nordwestbahnhof station in Vienna's 2nd district**, with the theme of "regeneration". Soma Difusa made a mural with Colombian endemic flowers with human bodies, titled Polinizadorxs. We invite you to visit all the murals, especially the one from Colombia.

#### + Pragatá, Countries and Regions Exhibition +


